United Sunday celebrated at Greater Pentecostal Temple

KANSAS CITY, Kan. - United Way of Wyandotte County's Faith Community Council hosted its annual United Sunday worship service at Greater Pentecostal Temple yesterday. It was the culmination of the Faith Campaign as members of all denominations joined in worship.

"We're excited about our partnership with the Faith Community as it takes the next step to become more active in the community," Wendell Maddox, CEO and President of United Way of Wyandotte County, said.

Area clergy and their congregations participated by bringing their completed campaign and offerings. The campaign reached its goal of \$16,000, which equals the largest Faith Campaign to date.

"This was a breakthrough year for the Faith Campaign, and we plan to continue striving forward to help united area congregations," Father Ron Reed of St. Paul's Episcopal Church and chairman of the Faith Community Council said.

United Sunday is an annual nondenominational worship service. It's a part of a wide range of activities included in United Way's Faith Campaign, which are aimed at supporting services for the needy in Wyandotte County. United Way of Wyandotte County supports 10 area faith-based organizations receiving more than a total of \$700,000 annually.
